The start of the new year means it is once again time for the GCBA Handicap Tournament. The Preliminary Schedule is available in each bowling center. Take a look at it to verify the date and time you are scheduled to bowl. If you have a conflict, call the number on the front page of the schedule to change your date. If you did not get a chance to enter the tournament, you still have until February 6th to enter. You can look at the Preliminary Schedule, see what is available and call the number on the front of the schedule to make your reservation.

DAN NICKLIN WINS SENIOR CLASSIC

Congratulations to newly inducted GCBA Hall of Fame Member Dan Nicklin for winning the GCBA Senior Scratch Classic held on November 4th at Bartelso Bowl. The tournament was divided into two divisions – those between the ages of 50 & 59 and those 60 years of age and older. In the 50 -59 age division, the top four qualifiers with their four game totals were: (1) Dan Winkeler 862; (2) Dan Nicklin 858; (3) Lim Loesche 847; and (4) Ron Hellmann 847. In match play, the fourth seed Ron Hellmann defeated top qualifier Dan Winkeler 205-160. The second seed Dan Nicklin defeated the third seed Jim Loesche 211-184. Dan Nicklin then defeated Ron Hellmann 215-198 to win the division.

In the 60 years of age and older division, the top four qualifiers with their four game totals were: (1)

Les Beer 830; (2) Bob Fischer 782; (3) Dave Potts 770; and (4) Ray Merian 769. In match play, top qualifier Les Beer defeated the fourth seed Ray Merian 177-160. The third seed Dave Potts defeated the second seed Bob Fischer 196-175. Dave Potts then defeated Les Beer to win the division. In the championship match, Dan Nicklin defeated Dave Potts 236- 202 to become the overall Greater Carlyle USBC Bowling Association Senior Scratch Champion.

Next year's GCBA Senior Scratch Classic is tentatively scheduled for Sunday, November 2, 2008 at 4th Street Lanes in Greenville

DOUG BUEHRER WINS SCRATCH CLASSIC

Congratulations to Doug Buehrer for winning the GCBA Scratch Classic held on December 2nd at Ten Pin Bowl in Carlyle. Fifty (50) bowlers packed the lanes bowling one game on each pair of lanes in the house. The top five qualifiers with their five game totals were: (1) Doug Buehrer 1198; (2) Steve Ludwig 1196; (3) John Helige 1153; (4) Jason Timmermann 1118; and Kent Korte 1099. The top five qualifiers then competed in a "TV STYLE" In the first match, Jason stepladder finals. Timmermann defeated Kent Korte 246-205. In the second match, John Helige defeated Jason Timmermann 200-194. In the third match, John Helige defeated Steve Ludwig 228-164. And in the final match, Doug Buehrer defeated John Helige 198-182 to become the Greater Carlyle USBC Bowling Association Scratch Classic Champion. 298 & 299 RINGS

USBC no longer provides a ring to bowlers for bowling a 298 game or a 299 game. Instead, the bowler receives an 11 in a row plaque. However, a 298 or 299 ring can be purchased through Keepsake. Keepsake supplies awards for the USBC. Through February, the cost of the Siladium ring is \$69.95 which includes shipping. After February the cost of the ring will be \$79.95. Gold Upgrades are also available. Call Keepsake for market prices. To purchase a 298 or 299 ring you will need to call Keepsake after your award has been approved and you will have to provide the following information: Your Bowler ID Number, your shipping address, the date the score was bowled, the Ring Size, the Ring Style - Monarch (round face large ring), Royal (square face large ring), Majestic (ladies small ring), or Regal (ladies small ring). Every bowling center should have a brochure showing the different styles of rings. You will also have to provide your credit card information when ordering.
